Okaloosa County is a county located in Northwest Florida and is bordered on the north by Alabama, on the south. Located it extends from the Gulf of Mexico to the Alabama state line. Okaloosa County was formed in 1915.

Eglin Air Force Base, the largest military reservation in the United States, it spans three counties with Okaloosa County claiming the greatest percentage.

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the county has a total area of 1,082 square miles, of which 936 square miles of it is land and 146 square miles of it (13.53%) is water. The range of elevation is 0-235 feet.

The Emerald Coast is a popular vacation spot due to its miles of white sandy beaches and cool emerald green water.

The average annual climate is 68.4°F with an average summer temperature of 80°F; an average winter temperature of 51°F and an average annual rain fall of 64 inches.
