

2019 ORIGINAL SURTAX PROJECT NEEDS LIST

HISTORY

In 2018, the Okaloosa County voters approved a referendum to impose a ten-year, one-half cent sales surtax on taxable transactions within the county, effective from January 1, 2019. The surtax aimed to fund critical needs, including essential law enforcement and public safety facilities, vital equipment, reducing traffic congestion through road and bridge construction and repair, flood control and water quality improvements, and other public facility enhancements. A comprehensive needs list was created to identify projects to be addressed, and the surtax allocation is subject to oversight by a citizen led Infrastructure Surtax Advisory Committee (ISAC) to ensure transparency and accountability in the use of the generated revenue.
